Dear Parents and Guardians,

Although these are uncertain times, one thing is certain – Your child's education is important! If your student is attending school traditionally, they need to be here every day unless they are sick. The week ahead – Now that iReady diagnostic tests for math should be finished, Your student should spend 10 minutes a day in iReady math working on their “my path”. This will help with math fluency and targets skills that are specific to your student. **6th grade** math is focused on ratios and using tape diagrams to model the relationships between numbers in the real world. We are extending that thinking into fractions and finding equivalent fractions. **7th** graders are learning more about integers and extending their knowledge and thinking into rational numbers, such as fractions and decimals. **8th** grade has wrapped up learning about the properties of exponents and will use that knowledge to learn about exponential growth and scientific notation.
